- Approx \$3500 in the bank after scholarships are claimed.
- Donation drive is underway but is getting a slow response. Will resend out the info to families.
- Treasurer position is now vacant and looking for a replacement.
- Decision was made last year not to stock pile fundraising but to spend the money raised on current students.
- Proposed fundraising targets for the coming year were tabled ready for discussion at the October meeting.

Principals Report (Mrs Pierik) -

- A wonderful first few weeks in school and has enjoyed the positive energy in the school
- Successful visit from Superintendent Piet Langstraat who was very impressed with the school.
- School clubs are getting up and running with lots of positive interest.
- Plans are underway to celebrate the 40th anniversary of the school and the opportunity will also be taken to highlight some of the alumni of the school starting Sept.22.
- Look for a weekly email on Fridays with links to the website highlighting events and activities that week. More use is being made of social media.
- Current numbers are 525 students with 163 of those being international students. Numbers are expected to rise each year by approx. 30 students until we reach our capacity of 700 students.
