- The police have confirmed that they will ticket any cars parked on the bend near the fire hydrant in order to improve road traffic safety along the access road.
- Parents have provided feedback that the school website needs a bit of updating especially in the early year just after the Christmas Break. Tina to investigate.
- Photos from Edge Imaging continue to be disappointing and feedback from parents seems to be that the request for improvements has not been met and it is time to look at alternatives.
