### **Principals Report (Tina P):**

- Report cards went out recently.
- The last Pro D day saw several teachers attending a conference at Reynolds called 'Grade smarter not harder' as well as a number who attended a Google Summit. The next Pro D Day will include a talk from Alex Nelson on residential schools, a teacher collaborative lunch and then the blanket exercise in the afternoon. This is a workshop designed to explore the nation to nation relationship between Indigenous and non-Indigenous peoples in Canada.
- On November 14<sup>th</sup> the school hosted Elizabeth May for a town hall session.
- The school also hosted a meeting with the Ministry of Education/UVIC staff so that they could learn from our trial of the new Grade 9/10 Career/Life Programme.
- We are looking to start a new Best Buddies club at Lambrick which is a Canada wide programme which will start with Leadership students pairing up with students with disabilities for meetings, activities and support.
- Grade 8 transition day will be on 17<sup>th</sup> January 2019 – 6.30 to 7.30pm is for Academy students and 7.30pm to 8.30pm will be for Gordon Head Grade 8 students.
- New semester starts on 28<sup>th</sup> January 2019. The previous week will include Copernican Days and exam days on 21<sup>st</sup>/22<sup>nd</sup>/23<sup>rd</sup>/24<sup>th</sup> January with Friday 25<sup>th</sup> January being a turnaround day for teachers.
