

Grade 9 School Based Immunization Clinic

Students in grade 9 will be offered immunizations at Lambrick Park's school-based clinics on February 6, 2020.

Grade 9 immunization consent packages was sent home with students this week.

If you are new to British Columbia, or if you think that public health may not have an up to date immunization record for your grade 9 student, please contact the Saanich Health Unit.

Please discuss the information in the consent package and involve your child in the decision to provide consent to immunization. This should be used as an opportunity for adolescents to start making decisions about their own health.

Although a child may be immunized with the consent of a parent/guardian or representative, a grade 9 student can make an informed decision regarding immunization regardless of parental consent or refusal. This is referred to as "mature minor consent."
