Masks and Hand Hygiene Reminders:

Students who are unable to retrieve their report card through the portal may come to the office to have one printed.

STUDENT CONNECT is now available for use for digital/online consent for all district-assessed and privacyapproved tools. As a public organization, we are bound by the Freedom of Information and Privacy Protection Act (FIPPA). Because these digital classroom tools often store their data outside of Canada, students over the age of 13 are required to provide consent for usage. Students will need to sign in to the tool using their **school district username and password** to review consent items requiring action (to grant or deny consent).

Students, upon login, will see the following list of privacy-approved tools conducive to usage in high school:

GSuite for Education, FreshGrade Classic, Zoom, Adobe Creative Cloud, FlipGrid, Khan Academy, Scratch, EduBlogs, Mathletics






