Not many events during a pandemic. Preparing the budget was the big activity of the last month. We could really use a VCPAC representative to stay connected with other PACs in the district.

5. Treasurer's update

Dawn shared the PAC draft budget that was prepared last week by a small PAC working group with input from administration. The working groups notes that there is an almost \$2000 projected deficit. The group felt that with approximately \$15,000 in the bank, and during a pandemic, this deficit was acceptable and would provide a good balance of rainy-day funds and spending the PAC funds on the students the best we can. We will see how the year goes, and may allocate an additional \$2000 of funds in semester two for new requests. The year-long items have been allocated.

Discussed that the LamPAC has not be taking on hot lunch during the Pandemic and the need to cancel other fundraising events have also contributed to decreased revenues.

Budget and process was discussed, including balancing requests with revenues and trying to provide funds for a wide variety of opportunities for students (Arts, Athletics, Academics, Experiences, Emergency Prep, etc.).

Motion: To approve the budget as presented (Dawn/Sheri) Passed with no objections.

Cecilia and Melanie reviewed the contents of the emergency kiosk. Cecelia will replace expired granola bars and water. Melanie has suggested some new items for a lockdown scenario that can be purchased.
