Great sunny weekend for LP's Outdoor Ed class camping and learning to surf in Tofino this weekend!

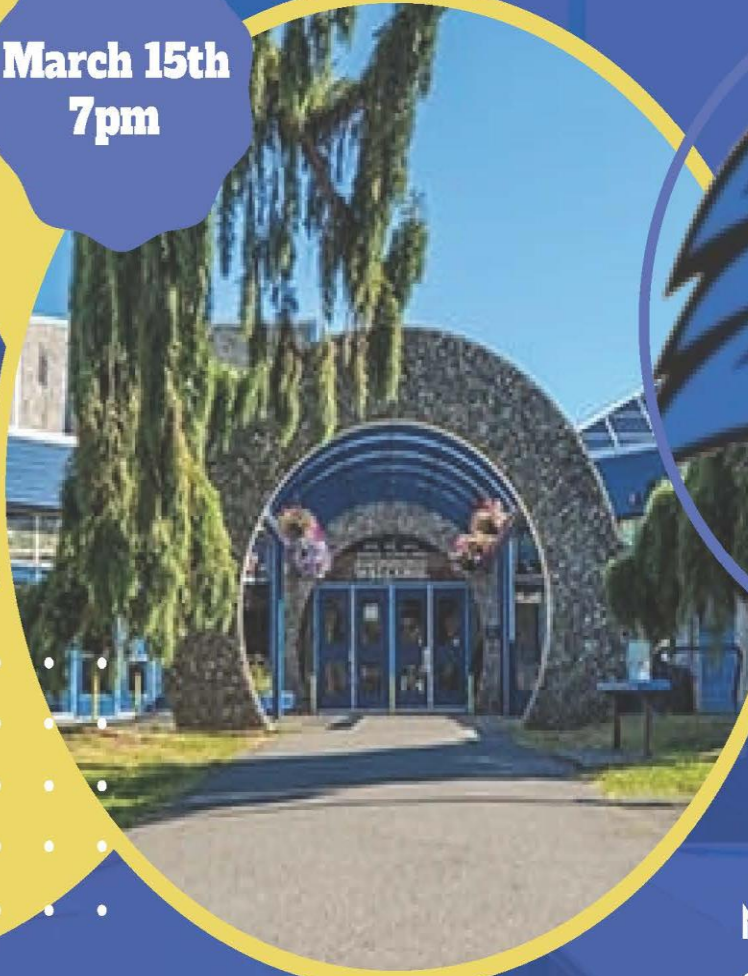
LP Girls soccer will be kicking off their season next Wednesday with their first game against Belmont - 3:30 at Tyndall field – come out & cheer!
