This week, we want to share some general information about school start-up.

First Day of School: Tuesday September 6th

Grade 9 students arrive by 9:00am and meet in the Studio (off of the main foyer entrance)

The plan is to have all important start up information to students on Sept 6th so we can start regular classes on Wednesday, Sept 7th.

Please note that student MyEducation BC accounts have been disabled by the district and will be available to students after September 1st.

Schedule Changes:

Some students will be hoping to explore potential class changes, our Counsellors will be at LP on Wednesday/Thursday/Friday next week during the regular school day schedule. They will do what they can to help students with possible changes, but the priority for changes will be as follows:

- 1) Grade 12's missing a grad requirement or university entrance
- 2) To address a failure from last year/semester
- 3) Missing a course in Semester 1 or Semester 2
- 4) Change of Elective

Due to the constraints of our schedule, we are unable to facilitate a teacher change or accommodate the need to be with other specific students in a class.
