This week's message is really to just welcome everyone to the start of the year and to answer a few Frequently Asked Questions we have had recently.

Our apologies if you have called and we haven't responded promptly; we have had some staff away in the office this week.

Tuesday Sept 6th:

Grade 9s to the Drama Studio/Room #1 (near the front entrance) by 9:00am Grade 10/11/12 Students in their A block classes by 9:45

How do I find my A Block? (many have been having some trouble accessing their schedules online...sorry about this. Some accounts moved to this year smoothly and others seemed to have some glitches)

Posted in various locations around the school we will have lists alphabetically by last name. Students can arrive a few minutes before their scheduled start, find their name on the list and it will tell them their A block and room #.

What should I bring on day 1?

Tuesday is a short day and students will only be going to their A block class for general start up information and forms etc.

Bring a binder or notebook and a pen or pencil to start. THERE IS NO NEED TO DO A HUGE SHOP FOR SCHOOL SUPPLIES.

Once you have been in your classes, teachers will let you know what is expected or needed for your class.

What if I have Gym or PE in Semester 1?

There is no need to bring PE strip on Tuesday the 6th. If you do have PE or an active gym class in semester 1, please bring gym attire (shoes, shorts etc) on Wednesday September 7th.

What if I am Academy Student... what should I bring?

NO need to bring any baseball or softball gear on Tuesday the 6th. Those students with Academy in A block will not be doing any activities on Tuesday the 6th

For Wednesday the 7th (first full day of classes) Please bring full gear as the plan (weather permitting) is to be out on the field.

This week, Acad staff will connect with kids about clothing and clothing orders next week.

How do I get a locker?

Returning to LP students (most of our grade 10,11 and 12 students) should be able to log into Student Connect and select a locker (instructions below). For new students and grade 9s, we will be running support sessions early in the school year so that everyone will be up and running on their digital accounts and locker selection.

We will see all of our grade 9 students Tuesday at 9:00 and all of our LP students Tuesday at 9:45!
